Instructions:

Place the verb in brackets into the present perfect tense to make a negative sentence.

years.	
9. They	(go) back home.

Answer Key

- 1. not have driven / shouldn't have driven*
- 2. has not passed / hasn't passed
- 3. has not collected / hasn't collected
- 4. have not ordered / haven't ordered
- 5. have not found / haven't found
- 6. still has not spoken / still hasn't spoken
- 7. have not eaten / haven't eaten
- 8. has not had / hasn't had
- 9. have not gone / haven't gone
- 10. has not marked / hasn't marked

^{*} When we include a modal verb, 'not' usually comes directly after the modal verb rather than after has/have
