- 3. If my car <u>hadn't broken</u> down, I <u>would have arrived</u> on time.
- 4. My brother <u>would have gone</u> to the concert if he <u>had bought</u> the tickets earlier this week.
- 5. She <u>wouldn't have cut</u> herself if she <u>had been</u> more careful.
